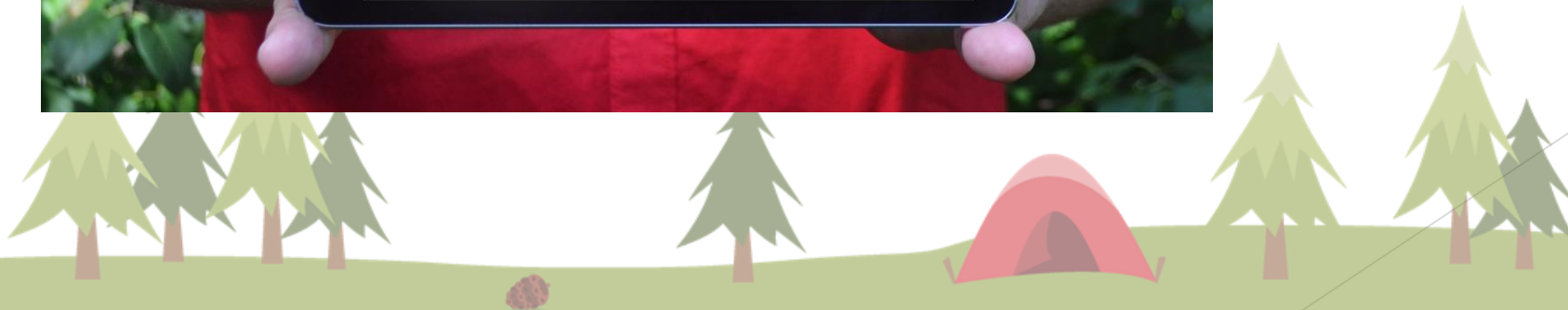


# New David Huestis Learning Centre

Scouts Canada is very excited to have partnered with D2L (Desire2Learn) to implement a new optimized and engaging Brightspace Learning Management System (LMS).



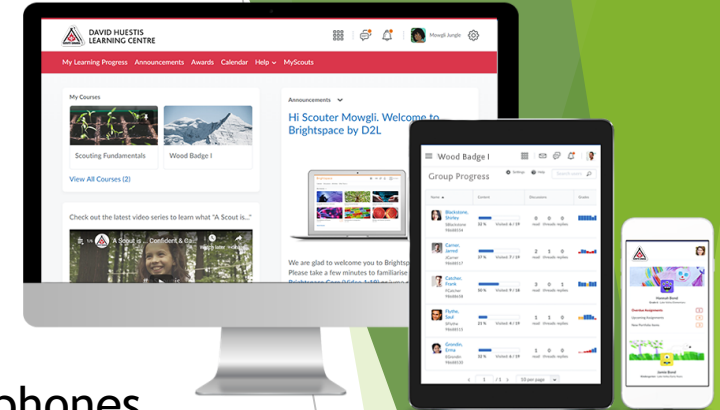

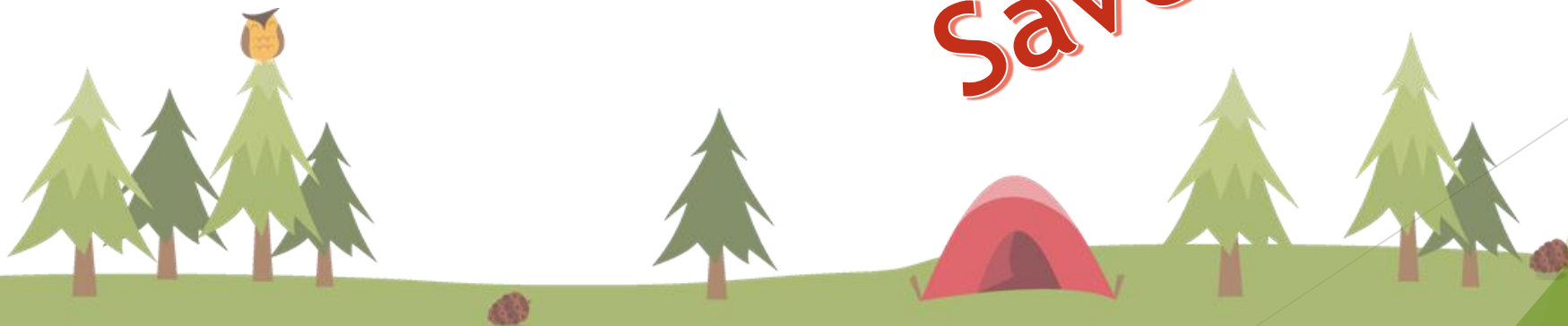
