The update on The International Scouting Program is that all of the planning teams are continuing to plan and organize for their events.

The Kandersteg Trip is now scheduled for July 4 - 14, 2022 (was 2020, then 2021, now 2022). I am the Lead Service Scouter on the CMT. All Groups have been advised of the changes and have been given the opportunity to withdraw in case 2022 does not work for them. Doug Reid is the Contingent Leader.

The AJ2022 Trip is on as originally scheduled. Since it occurs during the Australian Summer it is in January 2022. I am on the CMT for it; Dean Solway (14th Barrie) is also on the CMT. Kent Latimer is the Contingent Leader.

WSJ2023 is also a go at this point. The Canadian Contingent Contingent Management Team has formed and has started to undertake its work; I understand the Head of Contingent will be announced very shortly. I have provided supporting information to the Team Members on the Service and Support functions and will continue to be connected through that path. I am also the Team Lead for the Barrie Contingent and would be pleased to support any other Groups or areas to set up similar Teams.

All of the International Scouting Events are entirely dependent on the success of the current world-wide vaccination program. Final go - no go decisions will be dictated by the World Organization of Scouting Movements or Scouts Canada and will respect prevailing medical advice at the time.
