Identify opportunities to create a more inclusive organization, and engage Indigenous communities in an authentic Reconciliation journey.



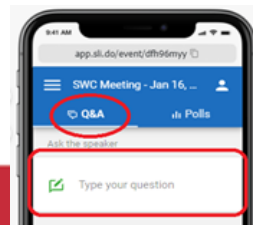

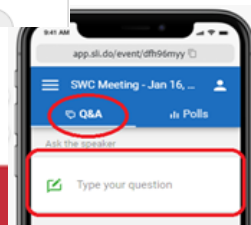
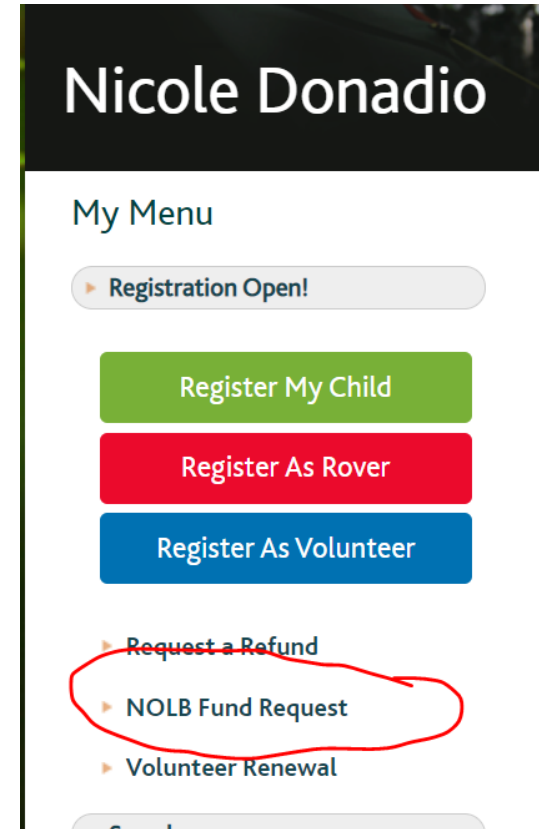
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NOLB Participation Subsidy Procedure

- If the application is approved, the funds will be dispersed to the group.

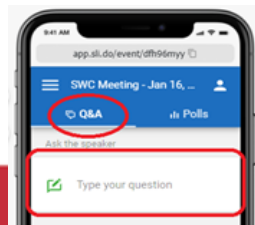


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General Updates Outdoor Skills Day Coming Up!

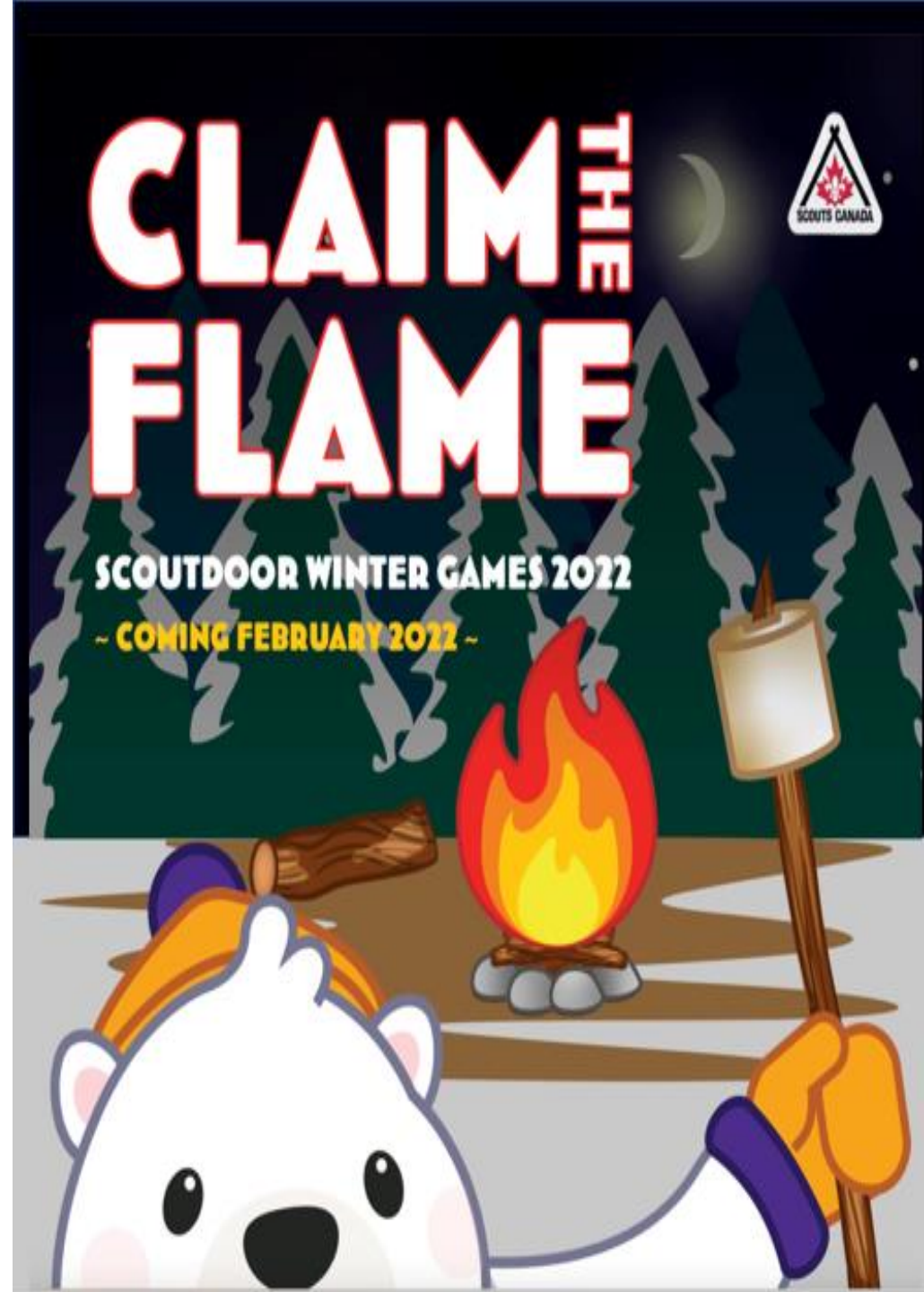

We achieve our Mission by empowering communities to provide young people with high quality Scouting programs facilitated by Volunteers. Ensuring that our Volunteers are equipped with the knowledge and skills to be successful is critical. Our Volunteer development program, Wood Badge, makes these skills more accessible through the Scout Method.

A key component of this new learning model is the Scouter Development Map, a competency framework that describes skills associated with each Scouting role.

To begin, complete the Self-Assessment Quiz below. For each competency statement, select your current Learning Stage based on past experience.

You will automatically be awarded the Competency badge for each skill when you reach the required Learning Stage as part of your Wood Badge I for The Canadian Path.

After completing your Self-Assessment Quiz, a personalized action plan will show below.

Stage 4: I Have...
Scouters have repeatedly demonstrated the skill with little to no support. They reflexively demonstrate the skill without necessarily thinking through it step by step.

I Have...

Stage 3: I Can...
Scouters can demonstrate the skill the majority of the time with minimal support. They think through the skill as they demonstrate it, and can describe it step by step.

I Can...

Stage 2: I Know...
Scouters can describe the skill and can demonstrate it with major support. They understand what they need to learn to personally progress.

I Know...

Stage 1: I Don't Know...
Scouters may have a vague awareness of the skill, but do not understand its scope or what they need to learn.

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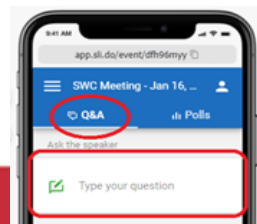
